

Antonio Dattilo, solved the case of white shotgun after twenty years

The DNA evidence would have shown that the human remains found last July belong to the young Antonio Dattilo, the young man who was never heard anything from 12 May 1996, a witness told of seeing him that day 19 years ago on the course Nicotera; the young man would be killed and probably buried and perhaps even tied with a rope because the scene of the discovery would have been found pieces of rope. Time must also be clear who decided why his disappearance and then its elimination.

The place where the find is not far from where the remains were found (25 April 2008 to 12 years after his disappearance on December 12, 1996) Photographer Gennaro Ventura, whose remains were found was the case under the the floor of an old cottage in the village of Carra - Frasse. It emerged that the photographer was killed, but apart from the discovery, has not yet been made light of that murder. Cases of Dattilo and Ventura (of which also dealt with the program "Who has seen it?) Then took place in the same year and at a distance of seven months apart.

To Dattilo was a case of white shotgun like many occurred in Lamezia in the last 30 years and never solved. There were no more news of the disappearance of Joseph Bertolami, farmer kidnapped on October 12 of 1983 and never recovered. Other unresolved cases are those of Joseph Montesanti disappeared on May 1, 1984 and spouses D'Elia - Iannazzo disappeared on September 24 1993. Then the disappearance in 1996 of Dattilo and Ventura photographer up to the October 21, 2003 the disappearance of Fernando Vecchi.
