Everything indicates that the basin that was fished last month in the port of Ghent belongs to Marie-Claire Vanhoutte, the woman from Harelbeke who disappeared without a trace in 1997.

Earlier it was already clear that the car that was brought up in the Zuiddok was her blue Opel Corsa.

'Both the elements of the police investigation and the findings of the law doctor confirm the suspicion that Marie-Claire Vanhoutte is involved', says the Ghent prosecutor.

The basin and the car were accidentally removed last month for dredging works in the port of Ghent.
