BLOIS - More than thirty years after the discovery of a deadly abused little girl along the French motorway A10 south-west of Blois, the parents were outdated and arrested. This reported French media. The mystery of the little martyr of the A10 has been clarified. The parents will be brought in on Thursday, according to news channel Europe 1.

Parents dead French girl obsolete after 31 years and brought in

In August 1987, road workers found themselves in a ditch along the A10 motorway, not far from the famous Château de Chambord, with a girl wrapped in a blanket. According to researchers, she was between three and five years old and only died a few hours before she was found. Her body showed numerous signs of previous injuries, fractures and burns. The police therefore assume that they have been severely abused for years and that they ultimately succumbed to it.

The French police and numerous media and institutions have more than once undertaken a futile search for family. The girl is buried like the unknown of the A10. The police accidentally linked her DNA to an arrested suspect who is her brother at the end of last year. After some months of research Tuesday north of Paris, this led to the arrest of the parents.

Her body showed numerous injuries, fractures and burns. The police therefore assume that they have been severely abused for years and that they eventually succumbed to it.

In August 1987, the body of an abused girl was found in a ditch along the A10 motorway near Blois, France. More than thirty years later, the parents have finally been superseded and arrested.

They are coming to court today. Thus the mystery of 'the little martyr of the A10' seems clear.

Road workers found it in a blanket wrapped around the girl near the famous castle of Chambord. According to researchers, she was between 3 and 5 years old and she had died just a few hours before she was found. Her body showed various injuries, fractures and burns.

The police therefore assume that they have been severely abused for years and that they ultimately succumbed to it.

Many searches for family have been undertaken over the last 30 years. The girl is buried as 'the unknown of the A10'.

At the end of last year, her DNA accidentally linked the police to a detainee who supposedly is her brother. After some months of research, this led to the arrest of the parents.
