## Missing chile: skeleton found

In the case of a Chilean student who has been missing since 2015, there is a surprising turnaround: the man's skeleton was found on Monday. This is confirmed by the Fahnder of the Salzburg Criminal Investigation Office.

The 24-year-old student wanted in August 2015 from Vienna to Salzburg and further to Bavaria. Carlos Patricio Gallardo Ramirez was on his way to the Berchtesgadener Land on a Europareise and probably on the road through Salzburg when he disappeared. The 24-year-old never took the planned return flight to his homeland.

Since then, the Federal Criminal Police Office, Salzburg and Bavarian investigators, as well as Interpol have been looking for him - but so far in vain. For Wednesday evening ZDF prepared the case for a special issue of "file number XY", also with the Salzburg criminalists.

## Wanderer found backpack - this led to skeleton

Since the weekend, however, everything is different: A hiker found a backpack on Sunday in Schönau am Königssee (Bavaria) off a fixed rope route. He gave it to the police. In the backpack, the officers found the papers and the purse of the abandoned young Chileans. On Monday, miners and alpine policemen rose to the site and discovered a skeleton with a further backpack after a short search.

On Tuesday, the court medics carried the mortal remains in Munich. Since Tuesday evening it is clear that the dead is the missing Chilean. A clear cause of death can no longer be ascertained, according to the Bavarian police. Nevertheless, the program "Aktenzeichen XY unresolved special" on Wednesday at 8:15 pm on ZDF is dedicated to this case.
