

Remains of woman who went missing in 2018 identified, located in Lochbuie

DENVER ([KDVR](#)) — It's been seven years since Terri Ackerman was last seen alive, and on Wednesday, officials reported that her remains had been found in Lochbuie.

Ackerman, 56, of Lochbuie, was reported missing by her husband on Aug. 24, 2018. He said his wife had been sleeping in her bed at 5 a.m. before he left for the day. Personal items, including her cellphone, wallet, cigarettes and car, were found in her home at 130 Poplar Street.

The neighbor told Fromm that he found it odd that it took so long to find her remains.

"I have never once seen police at the house," the neighbor said.

The neighbor called the announcement a sort of closure.

"It's closing, well not closing-closing, but getting to the point where they can close the investigation and what happened after several years of not knowing where she went and what happened," the neighbor said.

Police searched the area [extensively at the time of her disappearance](#), assisted by drones and RAMPART Search and Rescue.

The case is still under investigation by the Lochbuie Police Department. FOX31 stopped by the department's station on Thursday to ask for a comment or interview. The chief was not available for a comment.
