Homicide victim in 1993 cold case identified

BOCA RATON (CBS12) -- Police have identified human remains found in Boca Raton, 21 years after their discovery.

Police said a man found the remains in a pond near 6401 East Rogers Circle on Aug. 19, 1993.

The medical examiner determined the victim to be a woman in her 20s. Her death was ruled a homicide.

Police got the woman's fingerprints and used those to identify the victim as Michelle Deann Cooper. She was 31 years old at the time of her death.

Police believe she may have been living in the West Palm Beach area when she died.
